

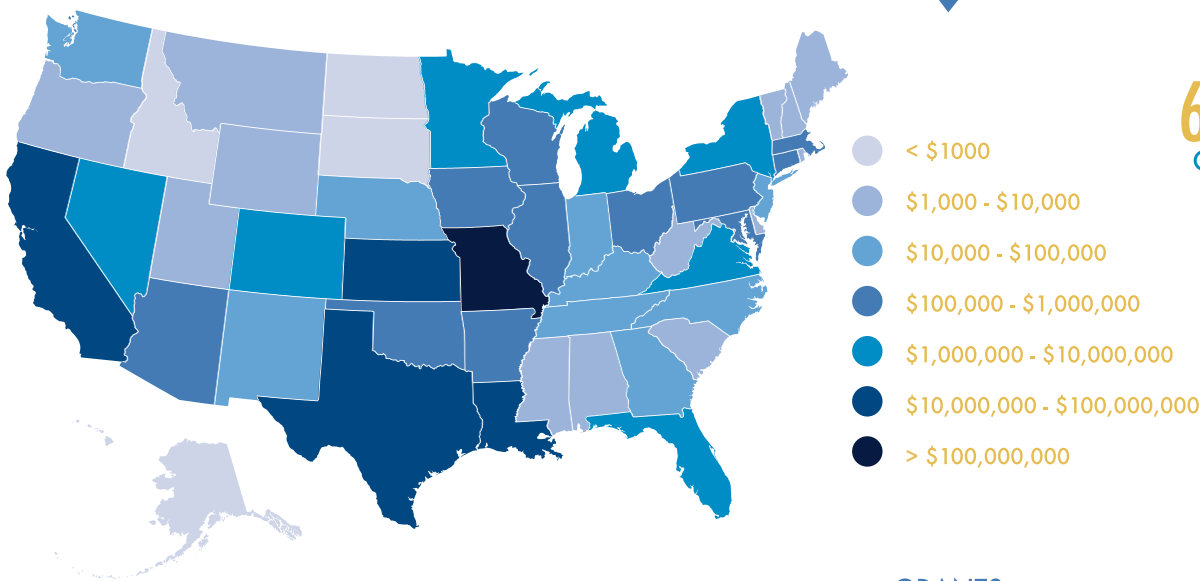

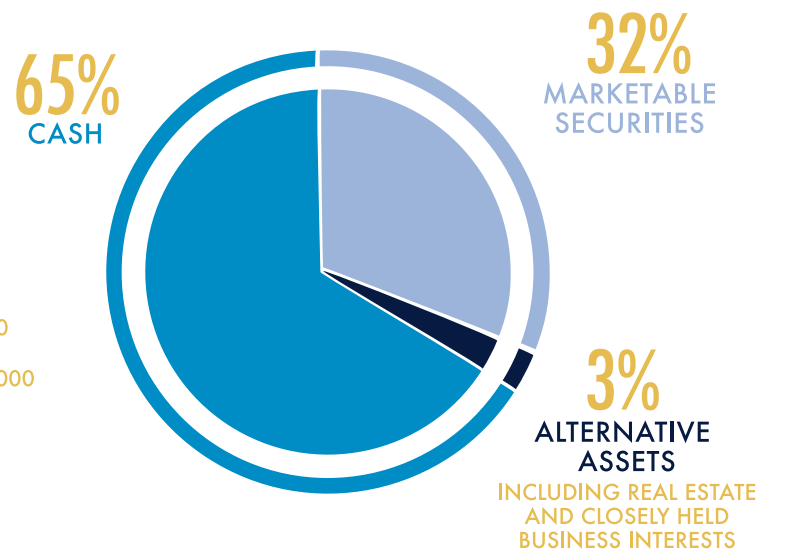

CONTRIBUTIONS BY STATE

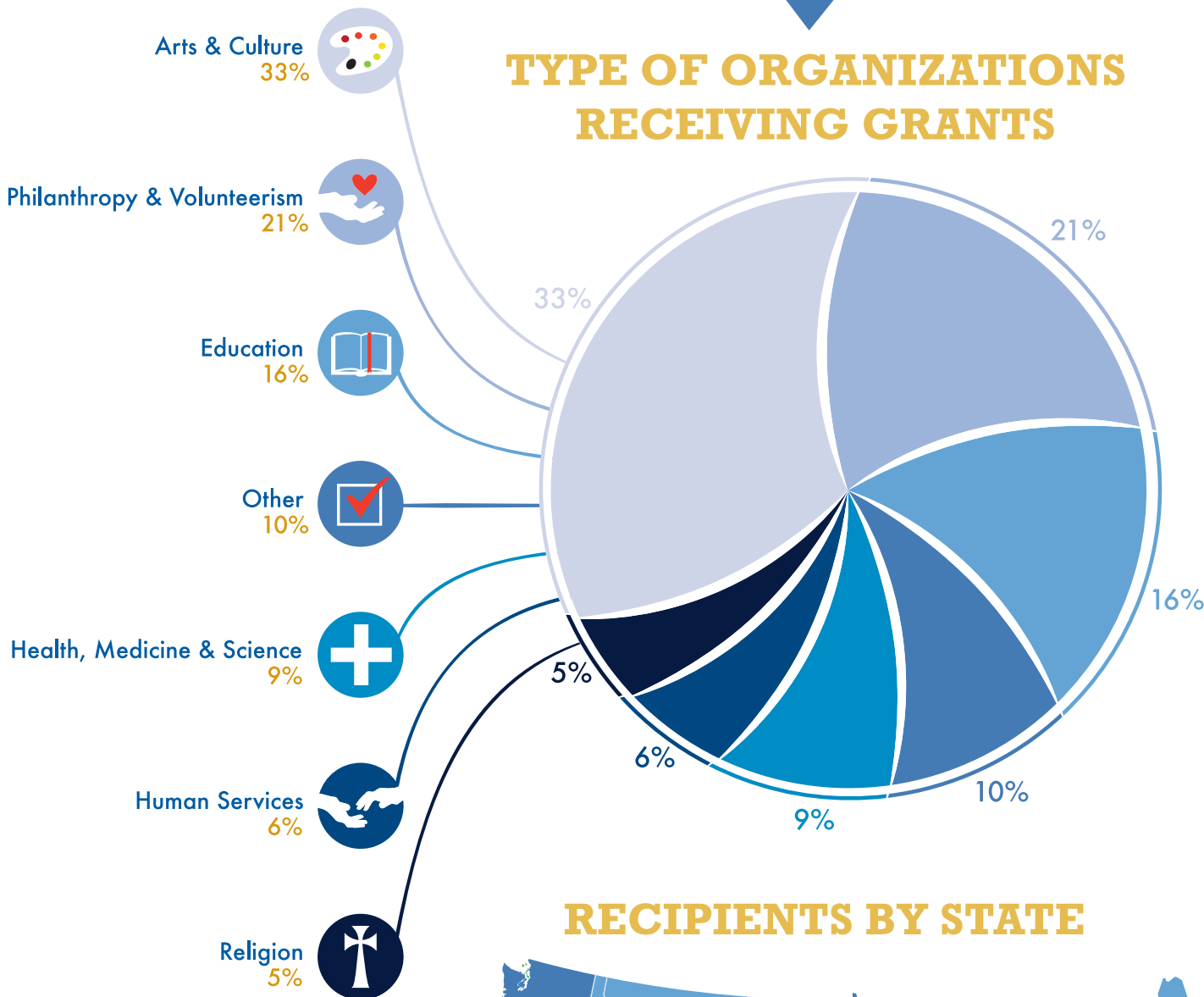


CONTRIBUTIONS BY TYPE

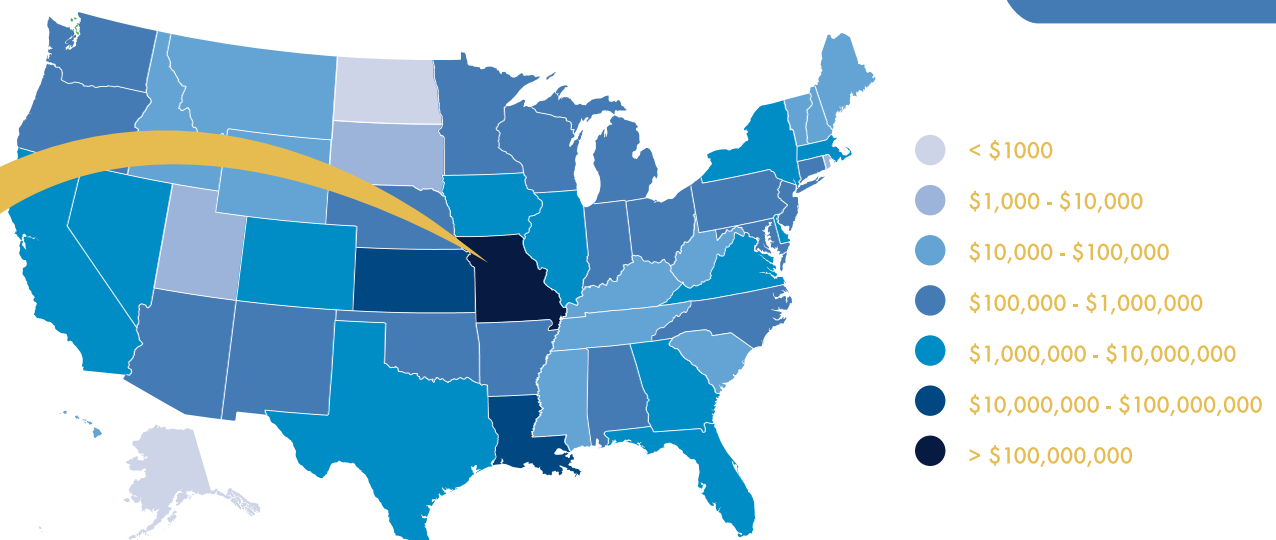
