

ELIZABETH MILLER WATKINS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

General Information

- Purpose:** To assist women students of *outstanding scholastic achievement* and *demonstrated financial need* in completing their college education at KU.
- Amount:** Awards of \$1,000 or more will be made to each recipient; one-half credited to the KU Office of Financial Aid/Recipient each semester by the Greater Kansas City Community Foundation (GKCCF).
- Eligibility:**
- All women enrolled as full-time undergraduate students at the University of Kansas.
 - Current residents of Watkins and Miller scholarship halls are encouraged to apply.
 - 3.0 GPA or higher on 4.0 scale
 - Demonstrated financial need;
 - Special consideration given to first time college women in family;
 - Recipients may reapply annually to receive the scholarship for a total of 8 undergraduate semesters;
 - Serve one year on the EMWMS Advisory Committee after graduation.
- Selection:** Selection will be based on application contents, a short essay on the life and influence of Elizabeth Watkins, transcripts, and financial information.
- To Apply:** Submit completed application, transcript(s) and/or other academic documentation (i.e., arts forms), and essay to:
